

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between the
Moreno Valley Unified School District
and the Moreno Valley Educators Association
In-Person Summer School
May 18, 2021**

The Moreno Valley Unified School District and the Moreno Valley Educators Association enter this Memorandum of Understanding regarding in-person learning for summer school 2021.

WHEREAS: The COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in school closures that have greatly impacted instructional time and student learning; and

WHEREAS: Riverside County has officially entered the Orange Tier of the State's Blueprint for a Safer Economy Color Coded Tier System; and

WHEREAS: Covid 19 vaccinations have become widely available, and

WHEREAS: Both parties agree to return to in person learning for the Summer of 2021; and

WHEREAS: The State has provided the district with one-time funding to mitigate learning loss as dictated by Assembly Bill 86 and the Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant to provide supplemental instruction for students during the summer of 2021; and

WHEREAS: The District shall implement all safety protocols required and recommended by the County of Riverside Department of Public Health and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

The District and the Association agree:

A. Safety:

1. The District and all summer school employees shall follow the safety protocols outlined in the MVUSD COVID-19 Prevention Program.
2. Out of an abundance of safety, the District shall cap the class size for all summer school programs to no more than 16 students per class and no more than 18 people per classroom.
3. The District shall provide all employees with a face mask daily.
4. The District shall provide all classrooms with hand sanitation and/or access to a sink with soap and water.
5. The District shall conduct daily temperature checks for all staff and students.

6. The District shall conduct daily health screening checks for all staff and students upon arrival to campus.
7. Any person that does not pass the health screening check shall not be allowed to remain on the campus.
8. All classrooms utilized for summer school instruction shall be cleaned daily and in between blocks to the greatest extent possible.

B. Elementary Summer Learning, Head Start, Elementary ESY, and Rainbow Springs Preschool:

1. Elementary summer expanded learning opportunity shall be offered at all the MVUSD elementary sites for current students in grades K-4 (ESY is grades TK-5)
2. The District will attempt to offer ESY at all sites, but actual sites will depend upon enrollment.
3. Instructional days shall be Monday-Thursday, June 21 -July 22, 2021. Except for the week of July 5th (Tuesday-Friday).
 - 3.1 Elementary ESY student hours shall be 8:00-12:00
 - 3.2. Rainbow Springs ESY student hours shall be 9:00-11:30
 - 3.3 Head Start state preschool shall be the same as elementary expanded learning.
4. There shall be no more than 16 students per class and no more than 18 people in total. Rainbow Springs ESY shall have no more than 8 students and no more than 16 people in total.
 - 4.1 If there are more than sixteen (16) students per grade level enrolled in a section (8 students per class for Rainbow Springs ESY), the district shall create a new section and/or move student/s to another site within four (4) days of the beginning of the overage.
5. There shall be no general education combination classes.
6. Staffing of school counselors shall be based upon enrollment.
7. There shall be RSP teachers to provide consultation for inclusionary practices to teachers for students with IEPs participating in the program, based on enrollment.

8. All certificated staff shall receive *up to 3 days* of preparation time at their sites (at the discretion of the certificated staff) for 7 hours. (June16-18). This shall be communicated to their administrator. Mandatory training shall also take place for elementary teachers for six hours within that same timeframe (June16-18).
9. There shall be no live streaming.

C. Middle School Summer Learning and ESY:

1. Middle School summer Expanded Learning Opportunity shall offer three different sessions at every middle school. Session A and Session B shall be Course Recovery and Session C shall be STEAM Academy. The Middle School ESY shall be offered in one (1) twenty (20) day session at a designated site.
 - 1.1 Session A Course Recovery shall be ten (10) days Monday-Thursday June 21- July 7. Except for the week of July 5th (Tuesday-Wednesday). Course Recovery shall be from 8:00-12:00 and 12:30-3:30 shall be available for STEAM Academy.
 - 1.2 Session B Course Recovery shall be ten (10) days Monday-Thursday July 8-July 22. Except for the week of July 5th (Thursday-Friday.) Course recovery shall be from 8:00-12:00 and 12:30-3:30 shall be available for STEAM Academy.
 - 1.3 Session C STEAM Academy Enrichment shall be ten (10) days Monday-Thursday Except for the week of July 5th (Tuesday-Friday). Section one (1) June 21-July 7. Section two (2) July 8-July 22 shall be 8:30-12:00 and 12:30-3:30.
 - 1.4 ESY shall be twenty (20) days Monday - Thursday June 21 - July 22. Except for the week of July 5th (Tuesday - Friday). Student hours shall be 8:00-12:00.
2. SEL lessons shall be provided by a school counselor virtually to all students twice a week for 30 minutes to the extent possible.
3. There shall be no more than sixteen (16) students per class and no more than 18 people in total.
 - 3.1 If there are more than sixteen (16) students enrolled in a class the district shall create another section or move student/s to another site

within two (2) days of the beginning of the overage for all ten (10) day sessions and within four (4) days for all twenty (20) day sessions and ESY.

4. Course recovery courses shall be limited to no more than two (2) online sections per teacher.
5. There shall be RSP teachers to provide consultation for inclusionary practices to teachers for students with IEPs participating in the program.
6. STEAM academy will be provided a materials budget as needed per site.
7. All certificated staff shall receive *up to three days* of preparation time at their sites (at the discretion of the certificated staff) for 7 hours. (June 16-18). This shall be communicated to their administrator.
8. There shall be no 'live streaming'.

D. High School Summer and ESY:

1. High School Summer School shall offer three (3) different sessions. Session A, Session B, and Session C. All sessions shall offer Credit Recovery, Learning Recovery, and Enrichment. High School ESY shall be offered in one (1) twenty (20) day session at designated sites.
 - 1.1 Session A (10 days) June 21-July 2 Monday-Friday (Block 1 7:30-12:30) & (Block 2 1:30-6:30).
 - 1.2 Session B (15 days) June 21-July 12. Monday-Friday except the week of July 5th Tuesday-Friday. (Block 1 7:30-10:50) & (Block 2 11:20-2:40) & (Block 3 3:10-6:30).
 - 1.3 Session C (15 days) July 6-July 26 (Block 1 7:30-10:50) Block 2 11:20-2:40) (Block 3:10-6:30).
 - 1.4 ESY (20 days) June 21 - July 22. Student hours shall be 7:30-2:00.
2. There shall be no more than 16 students per class and no more than 18 people in total.
 - 2.1 If there are more than sixteen (16) students enrolled in a class the district shall create another section or move student/s to another site within two (2) days of the beginning of the overage for all ten (10) day sessions and within three (3) days for all fifteen (15) day sessions.

4. SEL lessons shall be provided by a school counselor virtually to all students twice a week for 30 minutes to the extent possible.
5. There shall be RSP teachers to provide consultation for inclusionary practices to teachers for students with IEPs participating in the program.
6. All certificated staff shall receive *up to three days* of preparation time at their sites (at the discretion of the certificated staff) for 7 hours. (June 16-18). This shall be communicated to their administrator.
7. There shall be no live streaming.

E. Alessandro School ESY:

1. There shall be no more than 12 students per class and no more than 15 people in total.
 - 1.1. If there are more than twelve (12) students per grade level enrolled in a section, the district shall create a new section within four (4) days of the beginning of the overage.
 - 1.2. ESY (20 days) June 21 - July 22
Grades Tk-8 8:00 - 12:00
Grades 9-12 7:30 - 2:00
2. All certificated staff shall receive *up to three days* of preparation time at their sites (at the discretion of the certificated staff) for 7 hours. (June 16-18). This shall be communicated to their administrator.
3. SEL lessons shall be provided by a school counselor virtually to all students twice a week for 30 minutes to the extent possible.
4. There shall be no live streaming.

F. Distance Learning:

1. MVOA shall be the option for students requesting distance learning (following the MVOA Independent Study model).

G. Salary Schedule:

1. Certificated staff shall be paid based on their salary scheduled hourly rate.
2. Summer School Paychecks shall be issued during the regular summer school pay period except for High School Session C, which will be paid on the August payroll.
3. All certificated staff shall follow the usual process for submitting time sheets.

H. Term:

1. Both parties agree to meet and confer throughout the implementation of this MOU in order to address any potential issues.
2. The District and Association agree to discuss the terms of this MOU no later than October 31, 2021 in order to evaluate its effectiveness and discuss the possible use of this program for the 2021-22 summer program or regular school year inter-sessions.
